Star Wars Episode One: The Phantom Menace has been released!

Emperor Palpatine first rose to power almost 35 years ago when he was elected by the Old Republic Senate to the position of Supreme Chancellor. In this position, which had no real power under his predecessor Valorum, Palpatine eliminated most of the bureacracy and consolidated power unto himself. During this time, and in the time of rapid expansion that followed, many historic records were lost. With the Rebellion capturing Coruscant last year, the Empire's most prized (if untapped) resource of historical information, the Emperor's personal archives, were lost to us as well.

As you should all know, the Emperor's Hammer was founded by Emperor Palpatine himself when he promoted a then little-known General Stephan Ronin to the position of Wing Commander aboard the Imperial Star Destroyer Avenger. In the years since, the Hammer has benefitted from the Emperor's benevolence - even after his death. From time to time, Grand Admiral Ronin has received mysterious communiques in which new resources and their locations have been revealed. The TIE Defender, the Missile Boat, even the SSSD Sovereign - all these gifts to the Fleet have been results of these messages.

Most of these messages have contained information related to certain technologies. For the first time, one of these messages also contains some of the lost history of Palpatine's rise to power. These files, which came as a holodrama titled "The Phantom Menace", detail the maneuvers Palpatine was forced to make in order to trigger his election as Supreme Chancellor. Also included is information pertaining to Palpatine's alter-ego Darth Sidious and his first apprentice Darth Maul. These files also offer a surprising first look at the early life of one Anakin Skywalker - the child who (for a time) shed the cumbersome trappings of the light side and eventually became the traitorous Darth Vader.

It is highly recommended that all Fleet personnel view this historical holodrama as soon as possible. Not only does it present some important facts about the history of the Empire, but it also hints at what could be in our future.

Yes, I know the report has been late this week. I've been hard at work with the online database and have made some improvements!

A new Medal Board has been constructed to work with the existing rosters. Unfortunately, because of the difference in database structures, the old medal board data can't simply be imported into the new one...meaning that about 400+ medal records have to be inputted manually like the rosters had to be a few weeks ago. Medals are now listed on a person's "Personnel Profile" (here's mine for an example: http://www.tiecorps.org/rosters/personnel.asp?record=691)

Recommendation forms for the old medal board have been taken offline.

Here's how to recommend medals using the automated form:

- * Go to Administration (http://www.tiecorps.org/rosters/admin.asp) and log in
- * Go to Personnel Search (http://www.tiecorps.org/rosters/search.asp) and find the person you wish to recommend
- * Click "Recommend Medal" on the pilot's profile

This system might seem awkward at this time, but a friendlier interface will be in development at a later date.

As for the current situation with the medal records, this will be handled by the Operations Office.

Using the new database might seem complicated for many people, so the Flight Office will be constructing a "Database Manual" that provides easy-to-use instructions on how to access the many features that are being added to the database every day!

What's coming up (within the next two reports):

- * PLT Daedalus Update and roster clean-up...
- * "Medal Board" containing lists of pilots whom have been awarded specific medals
- * Updated Battle Board to list completed battles and free missions, high scores, etc.
- * Online Battle Submission Form system (which will automatically find and pull high scores)

Anyway, because the database development is taking up too much of my time, I'm going to be making a few changes...

First, since the FOA title can only go to one person, I've got a little problem since I want two people to sub-admin the message boards for me....so I'll make up titles for you guys to hold later or something, but in the meantime, you'll have to settle being able to write your name in a fancy color of your choice...:P

The new MessageOps are COL Kessler and CPT Khaine.

Throughout the numerous and numerous FOA applications, I got the idea of putting up a Project Board for those who want to do miscellaneous tasks for the TIE Corps for a medal or something...kind of like a "Classifieds" section so if I come up with an idea that I don't have the time to put together myself, anyone who wishes to volunteer their time for a project can.

Finally, for my Command Attaché, since his data-entry days are done, Admiral Horn (compdude21@aol.com) will now be responsible with collecting, reviewing, and tallying Wing and Squadron Reports from the TC wing commanders (but I still must be CCed!). I still read them whenever I can, but AD Horn will be checking to make sure they're being turned in and notify myself of missing reports.

I want to take the time to remind people that the Open CMDR Position page (http://www.tiecorps.org/rosters/cmdropenings.asp) still works! ... while it has had a notoriously bad reputation of being inaccurate and outdated, with the new database, it is *always* up to date now and does NOT include open inactive squadron positions! There are currently seven squadron command positions available!

Emperor's Hammer

The dark side of the force

A very special kind of online-gaming makes Star Wars- Fans from all over the world meet on the Internet. United in the web-club 'Emperor's Hammer, they fight their own battles on the basis of the Lucas Arts-Games.

The Internet-Club 'Emperor's Hammer' (www.emperorshammer.org) was founded in 1995 by the American William Call in New York. The actual motive in those times was to keep the story of the game 'TIE Fighter' alive and to continue it. Among other things members could find and post edited missions on the club-sites. By now the club counts a good 4000 members who - they want to be as authentic as possible - are strictly militarily organized.

Every member serves the Empire as a spaceship pilot. You begin your career in a low rank. The members are assigned to squadrons and flights, who are led by a higher ranking pilot. Such a squadron leader is our reader Natalie Muehlberger from Taunusstein. She told us a bit about her everyday life in her job. For example, she organizes competitions in which the performance of the members are measured. For this, a level for 'TIE Fighter' or 'X-Wing vs. TIE Fighter' is designed, in which the pilots are supposed to reach high scores. Every pilot now tries to achieve a top performance within a couple of days. His result is verified by the pilot's log file, prepared by the game program, which is to be sent to the squadron commander for evidence. The latter evaluates the files and reports to his superiors about them.

Other competitions like the writing of stories about the own squadron or the invention of mottoes and nicknames are assessed. The more active a pilot is in such competitions, the more often he will be decorated with medals. When his general performance is good, the squadron leader will notice and see to his model pupil's promotion.

To become a member of the 'Emperor's Hammer', it is required to have played certain Star Wars Games and to send the pilot logs to the Internet-Club. The club leaders have set up precise rules for a pilot's admission, they can be checked on the website of the 'Emperor's Hammer'. This Star Wars fanclub tries to be more than just a virtual place for online-gaming. Its members do a lot together privately, for example squadron leader Natalie - her name in the virtual universe is Callista D'Omàh - organized a meeting for members in London. In February a European 'Emperor's Hammer' delegation visited the club founder William Call in the USA. Even some love relationships have developed in the course of the continuous virtual contacts. The members of the 'Emperor's Hammer' meet in several chat rooms on ICQ as well.

Of course there are a lot of other similar clubs in the world wide web, such as the 'Rebel Squadrons' (www.rebelsquadrons.org) that fight against the Empire on the side of the rebels. But the 'Emperor's Hammer' is the biggest club of its kind.
